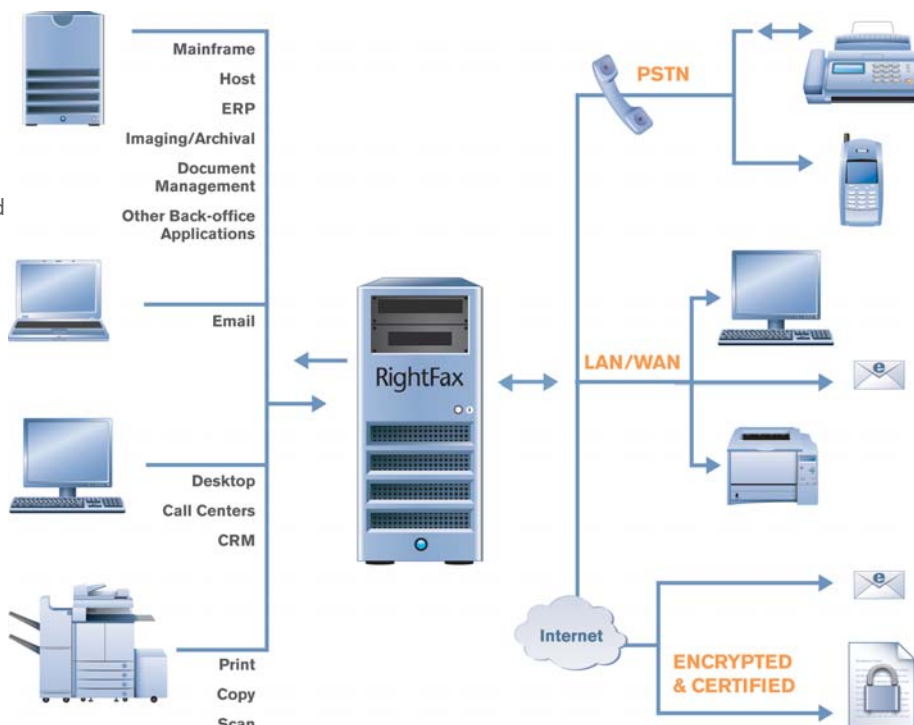

RightFax initiates process workflows. This can be accomplished by a simple network file drop, a routing rule or using the optional RightFax Workflow Wizard. To send documents RightFax enables any desktop or system application that can print to deliver secure, reliable, traceable electronic documents to fax numbers, email addresses and SMS accounts. Integrations with dozens of business applications provide secure, automated, unattended document exchange with partners, customers and suppliers.

A comprehensive set of administrative tools makes RightFax Servers easy to install, configure and manage—giving administrators complete control of their system. Synchronization with Microsoft Active Directory makes it even simpler to administer users from a single location. They are also expandable and scalable enabling organizations to accommodate growth, scale processes for redundancy and optimize throughput and rendering.
